

Christmas Light Sub-Committee Meeting

4.5.2024

In attendance were Andrew Stromme, Jason Herman, Matt Schanandore, Ruth MacDonald, Luci Snowden, and Terra Solberg.

This phase of the Christmas light project will focus on Main St. with potential future phases focusing on Memorial Highway and 1st St. Schanandore brought in a few examples of the current light displays for the sub-committee's reference while considering new options. Schanandore went over some suggestions and options in the extremelightscares catalog. The committee decided on a mix of the 3 snowflake options and the Silhouette Fantasy Tree for the west part of main up to Collins Ave. and the remaining options for the east side of main. Stromme suggested keeping the LED lights warm in tone. Herman expressed concern about the weight of the lights with regards to the integrity of the light poles, Schanandore stated that he would get specs for Herman. Schanandore stated that he was waiting on a quote for wreaths to hang on the shorter light poles along main street but Herman stated he thought the maximum weight on those light poles is very low. Herman stated he would check what the exact weight maximum is and would let Schanandore know. Schanandore stated that he would put together something to specify the quantity of each decoration needed. The choices of decorations will be discussed with the Community Beautification Committee at the upcoming meeting on 4/11/2024.

Preliminary picks for light pole displays are as follows:

- Presidential Snowflake with C7 removable bulbs.
- Spiral Snowflake with C7 removable bulbs.
- Winterfest Snowflake with C7 removable bulbs.
- Silhouette Fantasy Tree with C7 removable bulbs.
- Bells with Bow with C7 removable bulbs.
- Leaping Buck with C7 removable bulbs.
- Triple Poinsettia with C7 removable bulbs.
- Candy Canes with C7 removable bulbs.
- Hat Tipping Snowman with C7 removable bulbs.
- Christmas Ornament with C7 removable bulbs.
