Mandan Parking Authority

Mandan Code of Ordinances, Section 2-3-2(5) Parking Authority

1. The Mandan Municipal Parking Authority shall consist of five members and a city commissioner, all of whom shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioners in accordance with provisions of statute. In addition, the chief of police shall be a member, and the authority shall have a records clerk.
2. The Mandan Municipal Parking Authority is authorized to exercise all the powers and to assume all the duties and responsibilities as provided by state statute and shall have jurisdiction over the acquisition, financing and operation of all municipal parking facilities and projects within any commercial or industrial zoning district of the City and such other areas within any residential zoning district as may hereafter be specifically designated by the resolution of the City Commissioners.
